Meet Stella & Shep

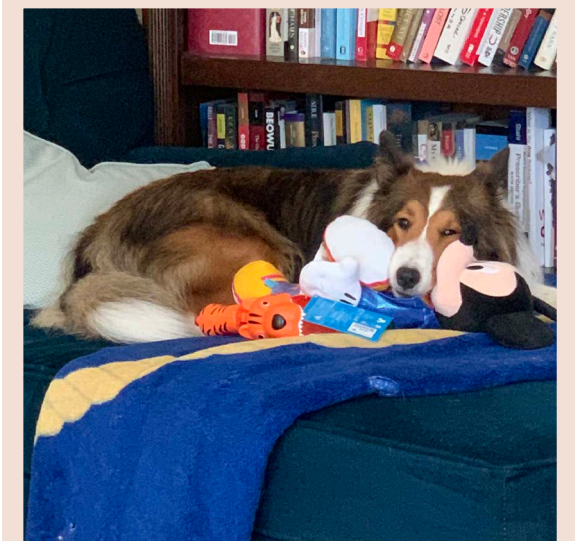

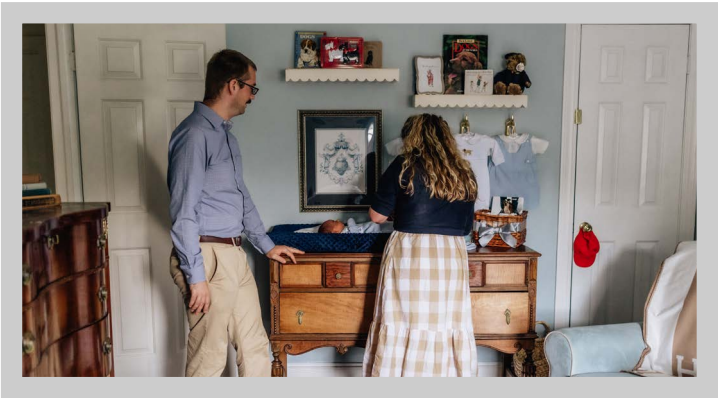


our Home & Community

Sadie is an amateur cake decorator and loves to make homemade cakes or cupcakes for Gus' birthday and other special events.



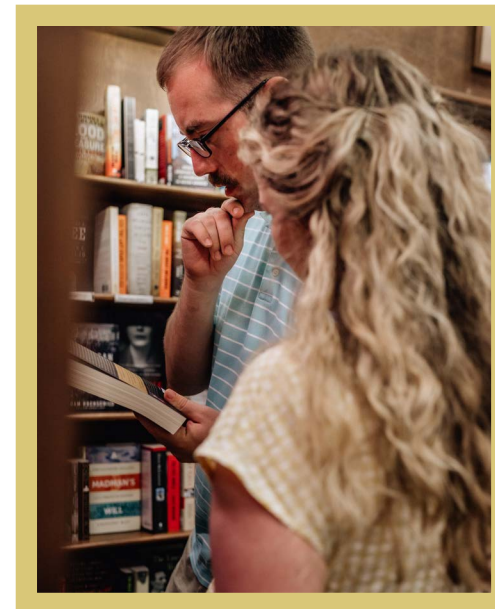
Shep's birthday is 10 days before Gus' birthday. We brought him home shortly after we adopted Gus and they have grown up together to be the best of friends.

Why we are adopting

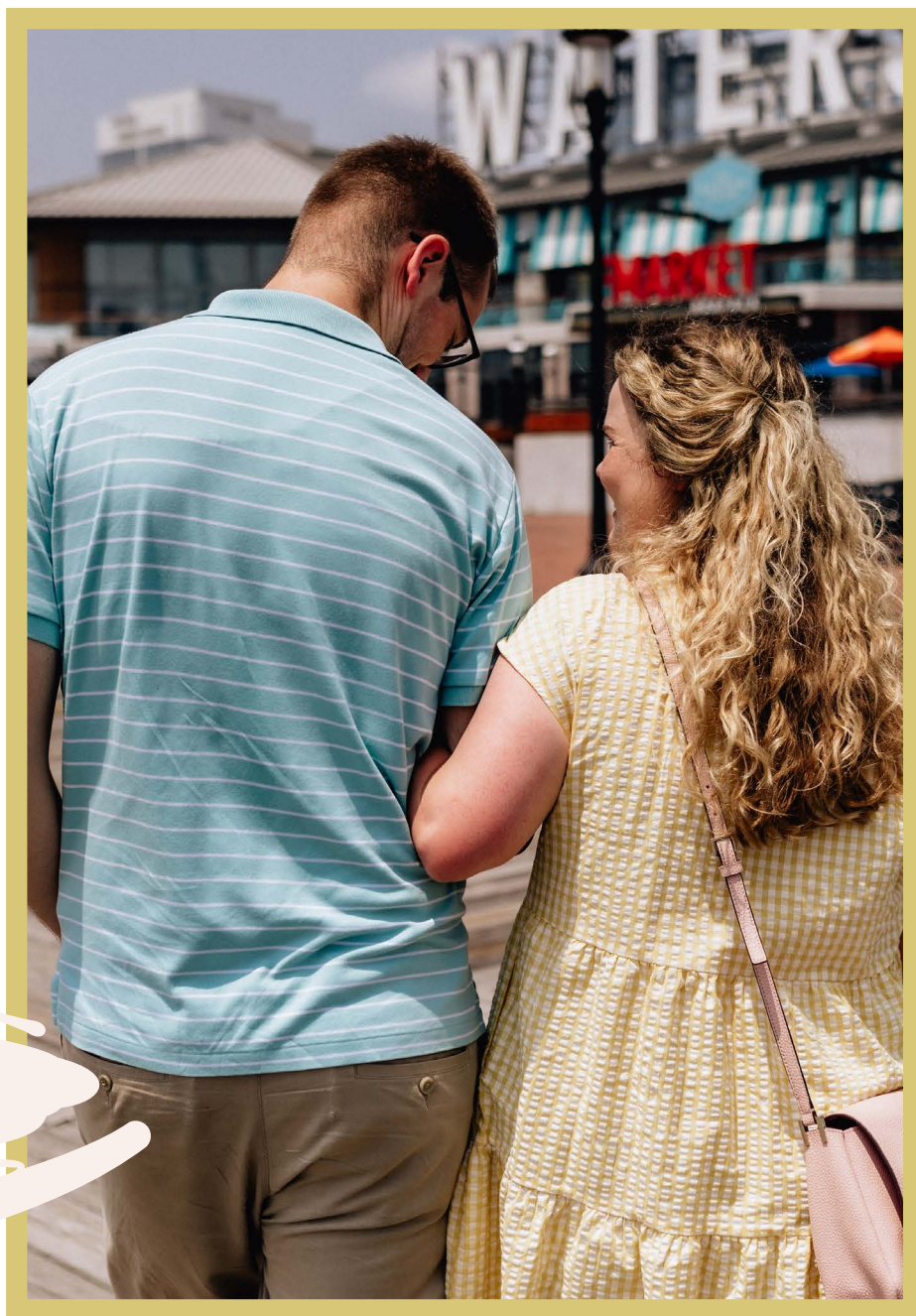
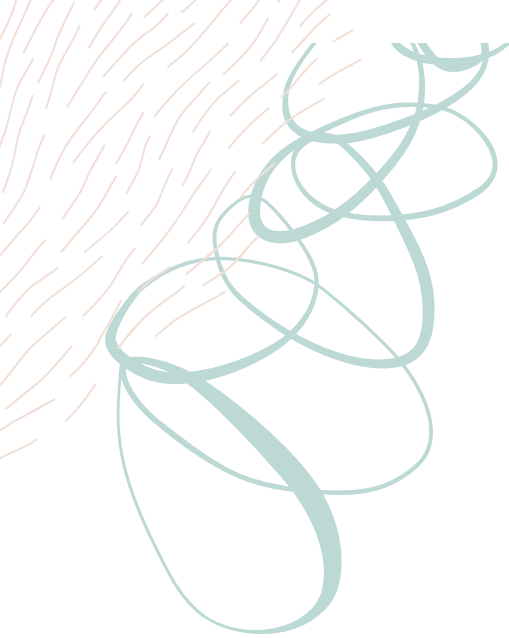
