Rita is known for taking the kids all around our town in her bucket bike. She has biked with our kids and their two friends all in that blue bucket.












Rita's family is welcoming to everyone, loud and fun, they laugh a lot and are very loving.
























### Our Home...

## Our Community



## Our Schools




